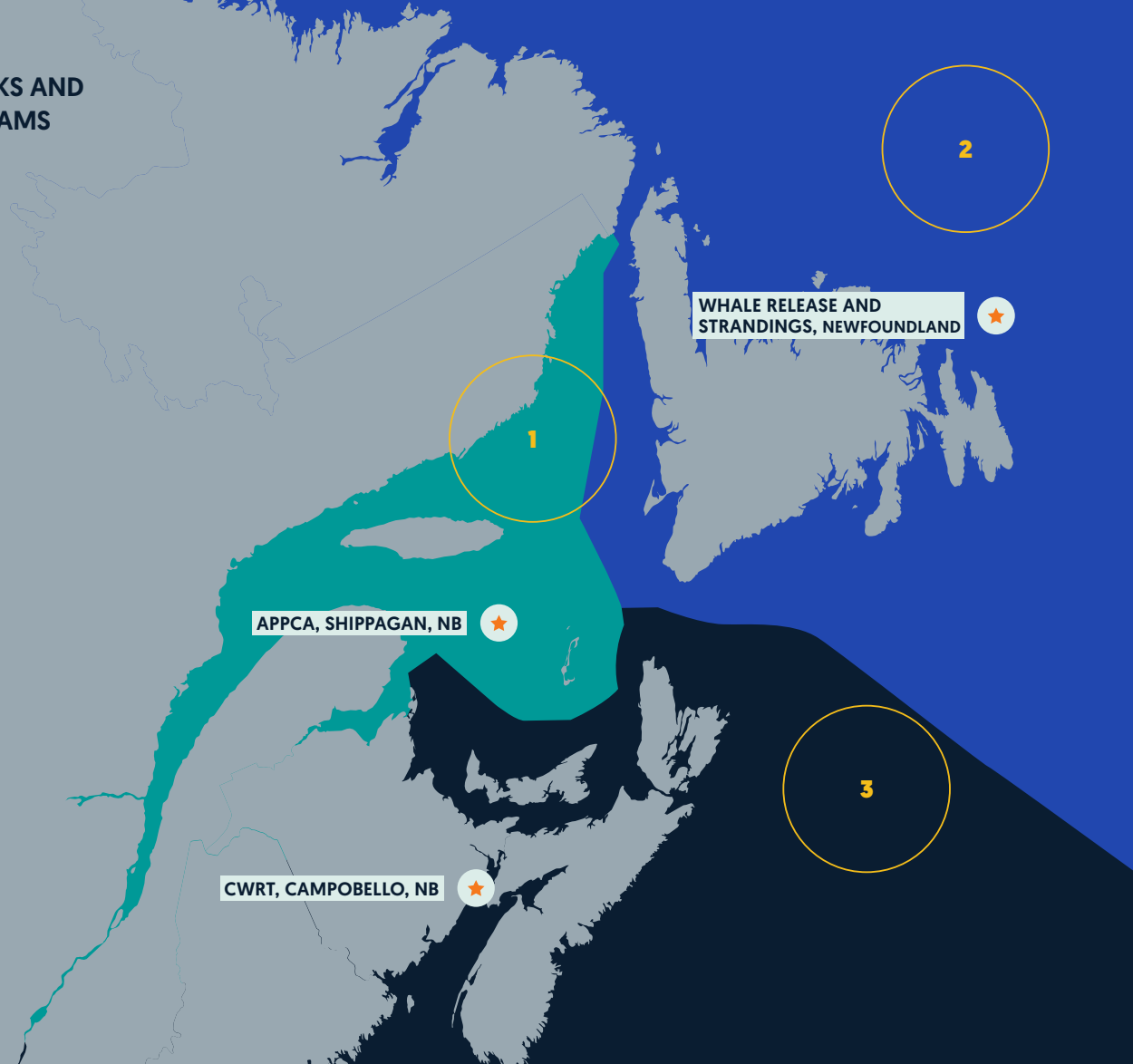


EMERGENCY NETWORKS AND DISENTANGLEMENT TEAMS



WHAT SHOULD YOU DO IF YOU SEE AN ENTANGLED WHALE?



1. Do not attempt to disentangle the whale yourself.



2. Remain with the animal while maintaining a safe, regulatory distance.



3. Immediately report any injured, distressed or dead whale to the nearest emergency network.



4. Take photos and/or videos of the fishing gear and the entangled whale.
